



DREAM TEAM APPLICATION

The Mississippi Theatre Association is searching for a “Dream Team” of college students for the MTA 2019 State Festival to be held January 17 – 20, 2019 at the MSU Riley Center in Meridian, MS.

Twelve college / university students with aspirations of going into theatre will be selected to assist the MTA Board of Directors and the 2019 State Festival staff with the running of this exciting event. These students will be required to work 20 hours of the state festival in one of the following areas:

- 1 – College & University Auditions (Thursday), Theatre for Youth (Friday), Play Reading (Sunday)
- 2 – 10-Minute Festival (Friday & Saturday), Awards Set Up (Sunday)
- 1 – Secondary Festival (Friday), Youth Individual Events (Saturday)
- 1 – Community Theatre Festival (Friday & Saturday)
- 1 – Festival Photographer: Auditions, Theatre for Youth, 10 Minute, Individual Events, Workshops, Playwriting, & Workshops (Thursday – Sunday)
- 1 – MTA Scholarship Student (Floater) (Thursday – Sunday)
- 1 – Local Student to Assist with Directions (Thursday – Sunday)
- 2 – Vice President Assistants (1 Thursday & Friday; 1 Saturday & Sunday)
- 2 – Executive Director Assistants (1 Thursday & Friday; 1 Saturday & Sunday): Registration Table (Thursday – Sunday), Adult Individual Events (Friday), Lunch Set Up (Friday / Saturday)

Four additional applicants will be selected to work 10 hours of the state festival in the following area:

- 4 – Youth Individual Events (Saturday)

Selected students will receive a paid festival registration, recognition at the awards banquet, and a great experience to add to their resume! Dream Team members will be connected prior to the festival and are encouraged to room together to assist with individual hotel costs. Applicants who are not selected to participate in this year’s Dream Team are encouraged to attend the 2019 MTA state festival as a participant or a volunteer.

Applications are due by **October 31, 2018**, and the Dream Team will be announced on **November 17, 2018**.
