MSU Riley Center Stage set up for MTA one act plays 11-4-15

Stage dimensions:

Proscenium: 29' 4"w 19' 4" h Acting area will be 29' w by 21'd Apron 7' 2" at center 36" at sides

Fire Curtain to Cyc 23', to black drop 23'7"'
Main Act to Cyc 21'2", to black curtain 21'9"

Wing left - 8' 4"
Wing right - 12' 6"

Stage is 41" above audience floor

Door Stage right – 15'-4"w X17' h

Curtains: Three sets of legs will be used for side masking, with the center one being a traveler that can be closed at 10'2" upstage of Fire Curtain.

Main Act curtain will travel not fly for this event.

There will be a choice of upstage black or cyclorama

Crossover: hallway behind stage

Lighting: Control will be ETC Emphasis w Express faceplate (24 sub-masters, 96 manual channels, 512 channels and recordable cues.

There will be nine areas on stage (3 by 3) grouped on sub-masters by; DS, Mid, and US with separate warm, cool and back for each group. Six sub-masters will be available for individual area control. There will be a full stage "night" wash and a full stage "day" wash. Blue Cyc lights will be provided. There will be three No color specials (DL DC DR)

Sound: Playback formats available will be: One MP3 player which will also play CD, one CD player and one cassette deck. Other units may be plugged in if brought. (You must bring your own patch cables if you bring a playback unit.)

FOH speakers may be used as well as one speaker backstage right and one backstage left.

Crew: House will provide:

Flyman (NO GROUP MAY TOUCH FLY SYSTEM)

Lighting operator (Groups are encouraged to bring your own operator.)
Sound operator (Groups are encouraged to bring your own operator.)

Scenery: Freight elevator to stage is 10'w x 14'd x 9'h. The longest piece of scenery that will fit elevator is 17'.

Four 10'x10' Scenery docks will be prepared upstage with 24" between docks. There will be additional storage area off right near freight elevator.

No scenery may be lagged, screwed or nailed to floor! Ample stage weights will be provided to weight scenery jacks. Stage weights must be returned to storage after use.

No blank cartridges, flash pots, pyrotechnics, haze or fog will be permitted unless specifically discussed in advance with the venue. No functional firearms will be permitted.

Dressing rooms: Dressing room assignments will be determined by MTA. MSU Riley Center is not responsible for personal property left in dressing rooms or backstage.

Intercom: Stage right, Stage left, lights, sound. Stage manger may be stage right or in light booth.
